



Self-pay (no insurance) solution

At Hana Rohan, Cardiology, P.C., we strive to provide access to medical care for all patients. We believe in financial transparency and provide a comprehensive and accurate upfront financial disclosure for any procedure or visit before you make your appointment.

We accept credit card and cash as a form of payment for self-pay patients. We ask for credit card information at the time of scheduling and will charge a nonrefundable deposit of \$80 at the time your appointment is scheduled. Our office has a no-show policy applicable to all patients and the deposit will be applied towards the "no show" fee (\$80) should you fail to attend your scheduled appointment without prior notice.

If additional testing outside of our practice is recommended and/or deemed necessary, you will be responsible for any third-party bills. The expense of testing or procedures performed outside of our facility are directed by third party providers and we are unable to furnish you with exact costs upfront. You will be responsible for contacting third party facilities to discuss cost and forms of payment.

Itemized list of services

New patient consultation

\$225

- Includes ECG, comprehensive evaluation, review of any prior relevant medical records, orders or prescriptions deemed necessary and coordination of care.

Follow up appointment

\$120

- Includes ECG if deemed necessary by the physician, problem focused evaluation and treatment changes as appropriate.

Testing

*****Our practice offers a wide spectrum of noninvasive cardiac testing on site. Due to our commitment to good patient care, we do not offer testing without either a referral (your physician will receive results and will be responsible for discussion of results and management) or in conjunction with an in-office consultation. *****

Echocardiogram \$250

- Ultrasound based evaluation of heart function and structure, used primarily to detect any valve abnormalities (i.e. murmur), evaluate congestive heart failure etc. This test is non-invasive and usually takes approximately 30-45 min. Results are typically available within 24-48 hours.

Stress test (treadmill) \$175

- Treadmill exercise evaluation of functional capacity, assessment of heart rate and blood pressure response to exercise. Typically ordered as a screening tool for coronary artery disease in patients with lower risk / suspicion for significant heart disease.

Stress Echocardiogram \$350

- Sophisticated stress testing option with addition of a full echocardiography evaluation which allows detection of coronary artery disease with higher accuracy and precision. Typically ordered for patients with concerning symptoms (higher suspicion for cardiac problem) or patients with a history of prior cardiac interventions.

Rhythm (Holter) monitor – short duration (1-2 days) \$150

- External rhythm monitor designed to detect significant rhythm abnormalities (arrhythmias) for patients with frequent symptoms

Rhythm (Event) monitor – extended duration (up to 30 days) \$350

- External rhythm monitor for evaluation of less frequent symptoms concerning for rhythm abnormalities (arrhythmias)

Laboratory (price including blood draw and/or fingerstick)

Basic metabolic panel (kidney function, glucose and electrolytes)	\$65
Comprehensive metabolic panel (kidney function, electrolytes, liver function)	\$85
Lipid panel	\$45
